Since its 1990 introduction, the prior *CHQF* Test Suite had become generally accepted as a *de facto* standard to facilitate the evaluation of Print Quality. Test files in the *SpencerLab* Printer Test Suite complement recent and forthcoming ISO/IEC standards (*SpencerLab* has participated in their development for nearly a decade).

More than a dozen firms sponsored development of the suite in order to have access to more meaningful measurement tools and standards, including Adobe, Canon, Eastman Kodak, EFI, Hewlett-Packard, Konica Minolta, Lexmark, Océ, Okidata, Toshiba, Xerox, and Ziff Davis Enterprise.
