Printer Test Suite Standard

Since their 1990 introduction, *spencerlab* test documents have become generally accepted as a *de facto* standard to facilitate the evaluation of **Print Quality**. This success has made it clear that there is an acute need for a broader standard with which to identify continuing innovation in improving **Throughput Speed Performance** and **Ink/Toner Yield** with associated **Cost-per-Print**.

The *spencerlab* division of Spencer & Associates is filling this void with an expanded suite of test documents. Assisted by a dozen key industry partners, *spencerlab* has applied its expertise in the testing of Throughput Speed Performance and Cost-per-Print as well as Print Quality, to develop a suite of standard test documents. With these test documents, users and vendors have a common tool to allow real-world "applesto-apples" comparisons.

Now it is easier than ever to **compare the print quality** of a wide variety of digital printing devices – without expensive test equipment. And beyond copies-per-minute, it is possible to learn **how long it really takes** to print real-world documents from everyday applications. Beyond the "5% page", it is also possible to learn **how much ink or toner** and other consumables cost to make real-world prints – even in color!

Building on earlier versions of the test suite, extensive testing expertise, and feedback from the most significant printer manufacturers, *spencerLAB* is uniquely positioned to respond to this critical industry need.

What is the spencerlab Printer Test Suite Standard?

The complete *spencerlab* Printer Test Suite standard comprises test documents for many styles of printing – home, office, production, and graphic arts. Documents reflect representative uses of Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint; Adobe Acrobat, Illustrator, Photoshop and InDesign, etc. Documents are available in international A4 as well as US domestic Letter A sizes, with some in Tabloid B and international A3, and optionally large-format. Black-and-white (monochrome) as well as ordinary color and calibrated (tagged) color users are supported. Test-quality images including skin tones, memory colors, highlight detail, shadow detail, etc. are provided in grayscale, sRGB, SWOP, and CIElab calibrations. Test documents are generally provided in both native formats and PDFs – in all, over 2 gigabytes of data! And there's more...

Test Methodology must establish an environment consistent with the intended product use, and a level playing field for equitable comparison. Issues range from appropriate document types to choices of workstation and connectivity, print modes, and product-specific options. spencerLAB's expertise and experience is also available to improve your in-house capabilities and for outsourcing your special needs.
